

To all VOI members, including anyone on the Technical Committee.

We are starting to renew our work with the BLM to re-establish our site on Cinnabar. This needs to happen quickly and without distractions, so please comply with the following.

In all future contacts with the BLM it will be with only ONE person. This is not a new request from BLM. We will have only ONE contact person to work with the BLM.

This does not preclude others attending meetings. But at their request, only the appointed person from VOI will communicate directly with BLM.

I have made the decision, after much consideration, that our contact person will be Don Lynn. He has had more experience with BLM, on this project, than anyone in the VOI. He was the single point of contact during our most recent work with BLM, and as such knows the in's and out's more than anyone else I know.

To be clear, I want no other person, only Don, to have any contact with the BLM regarding the VOI's application for permits on Cinnabar.

Anyone contacting the BLM, other than Don, will reduce our status.

The same request, as above, applies to Mike Cooper in his efforts to work with the Forest Service to establish a site on Shafer Butte.
